

Changes for next year to ensure the safety of the students submitted for approval from the Archdiocese of Portland in Oregon's Department of Catholic Schools and the Oregon Department of Education:

- Students will be maintained in their grade-level cohort whenever possible
- In order to ensure the safety of the students, until further notice, only the students and staff will be allowed to enter the building
- Students will have their temperature taken before they enter the school building every morning
 - Students will be entering at assigned doors at staggered times based on their grade level (entry times at 7:55am, 8:00am, and 8:05am)
 - Students with a temperature over 100.4 degrees will not be allowed to attend School
 - Strict policy will be in place regarding return to school if a child has a fever and confidentiality will be protected
- Per the guidelines, students that arrive late will not be allowed to enter the building and those that leave the school day early (for an appointment, etc.) will not be allowed back into the building
- For pick-up students will be organized by their cohorts and there will be two car lines that funnel into one line. For their safety and to limit the spread of germs, families will be asked not to park and walk up to their student(s)
- Student desks will be placed apart in the classrooms to allow for social distancing
- Student desks will each have a clear, plastic desk shield that is cleaned daily
- Students will be required to bring a face mask/face covering to school and will be asked to wear them in communal spaces when transitioning without their cohort
- Students will eat within their classrooms:
 - No microwave usage
 - No milk sold
 - Jewel's lunch program will offer cold lunch options for ordering, with disposable containers
 - All students will be asked to bring their own water bottle, which can be refilled with the touchless bottle filler. Water fountains will not be available for use.
- Specialist classes, not including PE, will happen in the classrooms
- PE will occur outside whenever weather permits and the gym at other times
 - Students will not change for PE, but can change shoes
- Students will get to have recess in their cohorts in separate areas on campus
- Mass will have only the hosting class in attendance, while the other classes live stream and participate from their classrooms
- Morning prayer will happen in our classrooms via zoom so that all the students can see one another
- Prayer services, such as Advent gatherings, will again happen via zoom so that all grade levels can participate together.
- Currently we are working with Vermont Hills Family Life Center to plan for aftercare for those families who need it-be sure to reach out if you need this service! However there will be NO Morning Care next year
